## Instructions

Use the following questions to start thinking critically about what you're reading. You can use this for each thing you read and make notes in the space provided.

<b>Questions</b>	Reflections
Presentation Is the information clearly communicated? Are there typos or other things you might not expect?	
Relevance Look at the introduction or abstract – what is it mainly about?	
Objectivity What is the author(s) position of interest? Do they state this or use emotive language?	
Method Are the methods or data appropriate for the study or findings presented? Do you trust them?	
Provenance Can you tell who the authors are affiliated with or where the article is published?	
Timeliness Is it clear when this article produced and is it current or out of date?
